## **Educational Tours**

In this unique educational program, students have an opportunity to visit the Route 22 Gallery & Gift shop to experience amazing local art in an intimate setting. They will learn about the structure of the Artist Collective as an organization, discuss/identify a variety of mediums of art, meet resident members & artists on site for a Q & A session, and then partake in an interactive sketching activity with an Art Educator in our MakerSpace studio. Students will be given materials to customize their own Route 22 pocket sketchbook to take home, and then be guided through 1-3 drawing activities designed to boost creativity and artistic confidence. In substitution or addition to this tour, students can view a short video presentation about the impact of art in society both historically or in modern culture. Students are encouraged to bring spending money if they wish to purchase items from our gift shop – there are many affordable options! Need to meet a specific curriculum learning outcome? ## Artful Inclusion Package

This flexible program package allows for 1.5 hours of guided art instruction for seniors or diverse needs individuals; offered as a field trip or as an in-house program at an alternate facility. Participants will receive demonstrational guidance and one-on-one support from an art educator to complete their chosen project from the following list, which have been thoughtfully curated for persons with varied abilities (one per session):

- Rocky Mountain Watercolor Landscape
- Card Making
- Paper Flower Sculpture
- Decorated Plant Pots (soil & seeds included)
- Photo Collage Boards

#### USER CONDUCT & RESPONSIBILITY

#### **PAYMENT & CANCELLATION**

**1)** All packages require a \$150 deposit to secure the reservation at the time of booking. We accept cash, credit or debit card. The amount owing is due in full on the day of the event.

2) No refunds will be issued for cancellations within 5 days prior to the reservation date.

**3)** The Collective reserves the right to cancel reservations if it does not meet the requirements as per the usage agreement or if user is found to be in violation of terms. Reservation will be fully refunded under these circumstances.
